#### Background

The UNFPA Independent Evaluation Office (IEO), EvalYouth and African Evaluation Association (AfrEA) YEE Network invites applications from Kenya-based African young evaluators to attend - free of charge - a five-day participatory, interactive, multimedia training workshop to strengthen capacities in planning, preparing, managing, and disseminating the results of complex evaluations.

- Be equipped with in-depth knowledge of the UNFPA Independent Evaluation Office methodological framework
- Gain skills in the preparation and management of complex evaluations, as well as in the dissemination and use of evaluation results
- Understand each stage of the evaluation process
- Acquire knowledge on how to drive the use of innovative practices in evaluation and deep dive into emerging areas, integrating LNOB (leaving no one behind) lens in evaluations, use of adaptive evaluation approaches, meaningful engagement of young people, among others
- Network with other evaluations experts and like-minded peers from diverse backgrounds.

#### Eligibility and application

Applicants must:

- Be below the age of 35
- Be an African living in Kenya
- Hold a Bachelor's degree in development studies, population studies, monitoring and evaluation, social studies, health or other related fields

- Have an evaluation affiliation in Kenya
- Have at least two years of experience working in programme management, monitoring and evaluation or in research
- Have skills in evaluation or research methodology and analysis, including quantitative and qualitative techniques
- Excellent command in written and spoken English.
